It is a 1960 Dynamic 88, two door hard top coupe, with chrome reverse wheels, dual exhaust, white with brown interior. CA license was IYN 562. The Value of a Friend: I am finally making some headway on my 1929 Oldsmobile. It has been a long journey since the 29 Olds was a year only car and parts are like frog hair to find. My hopes to finish the car hit a brick wall when I pulled the transmission for a rebuild. When I tried to remove the speedo cable the transmission rear bearing retainer fell apart. The old pot metal from that era had issues and thru the years it swells and cracks. This piece is not available. Even if I found one, I would have the same problem. I started thinking of putting in a WW2 Jeep transmission since I would never be able to find a replacement. A friend came by to visit and I was explaining my dire situation to him and he took a look and said let me have the pieces for a while. A few days later he sent me an email with a file for a CNC machine to cut a new piece from aluminum billet. Ron is a self-taught machinist and a wiz with CAD drawings. He sent the files off and had a 3D printing made of high impact plastic which we used to fit to the transmission to make sure the new unit would work. To my amazement, we didn't have to make any adjustments. The next step was to send the files to a CNC shop. As you look at the pictures, you will see the broken pieces, the black 3D printed piece and then the final product. Ron is an amazing person and one heck of an amateur machinist. His hobby is Hit and Miss Engines. A true friend is like a tow truck, they pull you out of the ditch of failure.


