To celebrate this time and kick start our club's activities again, Karon and I are inviting the club membership to our new home (new to us) to have an all-day gathering which will include a continental breakfast, and BBQ lunch so we can relax, enjoy each other's company again, and have some conversation regarding what our club should look like going forward with regard to club meetings, events, car shows, community support, etc...

We are encouraging all interested members to drive their **Oldsmobiles** so we all can see what folks have been working on, any new acquisitions over the last year and a half that we have not seen and return to appreciating the great cars that Oldsmobile built over the years.

Our new home, we refer to as "Warner Ranch 2.0" has ample parking on the property, on concrete, for upwards of 30 cars so there is plenty of room for everyone interested in coming and there are no dirt roads to get to our new "edge of the world" location...lol.

The new location is **6771 Braceo St in Oak Hills 92344** which is just at the top of the Cajon pass in a cooler 4200 ft elevation climate.

Directions are as follows; Travel North on the 15 freeway up the Cajon Pass and plan to be in the right lane as you crest the hill. Take the Oak Hills offramp at the top of the hill. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto the frontage road and go about 200 yards to the next stop sign. Turn left at the stop and go over the freeway and then turn right (only way you can go) onto Caliente Rd which parallels the freeway. Travel North on Caliente about a mile and turn left onto Oak Hill Rd. Take Oak Hill Rd about a half-mile down a steep hill and as you round the curve at the bottom of the hill, turn left onto Jenny St. Take Jenny St until it dead ends (approx. a mile) at our street, Braceo. Turn right onto Braceo and we are a 1/4 mile up on the right.

Look for the flagpole with the American and Oldsmobile flags flying and come on in the gate for a great club day at the Warner Ranch.

Time frame will be 9:am till whenever so come early in the cooler temperatures to make it a bit easier on your classic coming up the hill and stay as long as you like (ok, that is being polite---no squatters please...lol)

Look forward to seeing you all there.

Don't forget that June 20th is the postmark date to mail in your registration form for the OCA National Meet. A waiting list for sleeping rooms at the host hotel has been established- contact Jerry Wilson to be added to the list (his contact info is listed under Commercial Display Advertising on the masthead in recent Journey With Olds.) Rooms at the two backup hotels are currently available.

Here are the highlights of the May 5th OCA Board of Directors videoconference:

- Cost of OCA member discount bidder's pass at Mecum Auctions is now \$100, half the normal price. There is an OCA promo code to be used when registering online for a Mecum Auction to receive the discounted price. Can still get the \$20 or \$30 walk-around admission at most of their auctions, too. Shannon Olson (JWO Editor) may attend the Indianapolis auction and write an article explaining the auction sales process. Mecum is now advertising in JWO.
- OCA is a member of the GM Car Council, a group of the GM national marque clubs (other participants include the Vintage Chevrolet Club, Cadillac La Salle Club, etc.). The Council is starting a new website, which will include short videos about each member club.
- National Meet update- Jerry Wilson visited the Embassy Suites (host hotel) recently, they are now operating with large group gatherings. There will be an Editors' Meeting hosted by Shannon Olson on Friday during the Meet. The General Membership meeting will be held at 9 a.m. on Saturday. 121 cars (and more people) are registered right now. 73 swap spaces sold to date. The Embassy Suites normally has no overnight security patrol, so OCA will be contracting for overnight security. Special displays to include two race cars indoors at the Embassy Suites and Oldsmobiles in the "car cube" at the local GM dealer.
- President Sal Barberi is working on the formation of the National Meet Committee. He is seeking input (and volunteers). Sal also proposed having the 2022 Meet in Murfreesboro or close by, to give members that don't feel comfortable attending in 2021 another opportunity to visit the area. Also, returning to the same area would give the Meet Committee more time to get up to speed for the 2023 Meet. Jerry Wilson will ask the Embassy Suites about a possible return in 2022.
- Treasurer Jeff Walsh reported that we are close to breaking even in our operations. Although first quarter membership revenue was down by ten percent, this was mostly offset by an increase in advertising revenue.
- Miscellaneous reports: Our latest E-Membership drive (late last year) netted us ninety new members. Congratulations to Shannon Olson for another Golden Quill Award from Old Cars Weekly. Long-Term Membership Chair Cindy Klemm provided copies of the new static-cling OCA decals that we will be selling.

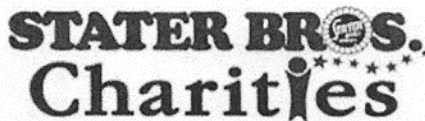

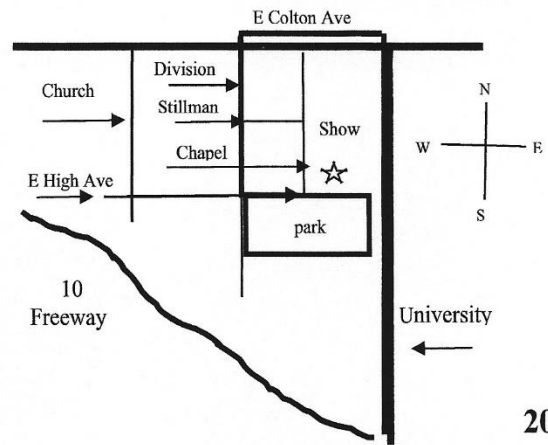

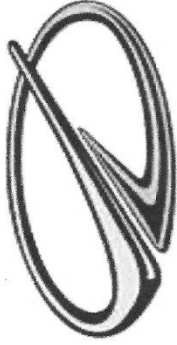
