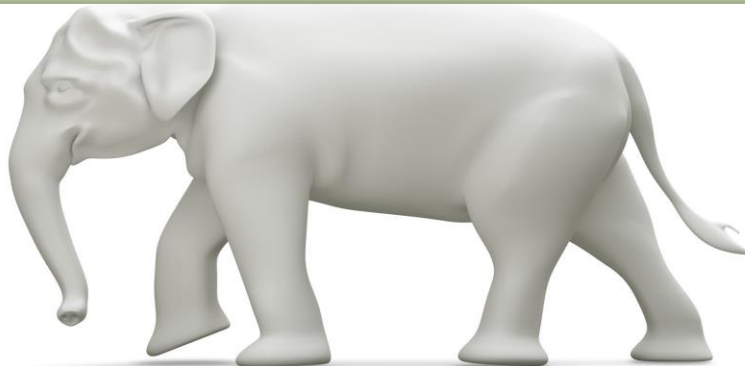

February 12, 2022, General Membership Meeting socialoldsmobile.com

February 12th Board Meeting socaloldsmobile.com Secretary Domenic D. Santucci

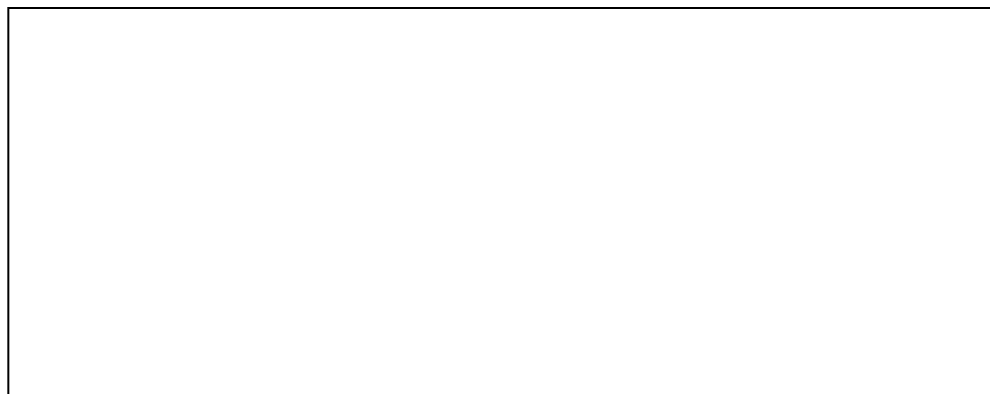
Joe Tannerbauer Area Representative hosted today's board meeting following hosting our membership meeting. Although Joe invited membership meeting attendees to attend the board meeting only board members were in attendance. Joe noted he will alert those on RSVP list for the Tom Malloy Car Collection that he will be sending out location addresses for the location.

Karon Pierce-Warner Chapter Editor raised the question to keep the zone show event more casual with a light meal at the awards this year. Karon also motioned to give up to \$200.00 to support a trophy for the event. The motion was seconded by Joe and after discussion passed. Grant Warner our Vice President will follow up on exact trophy cost to see if another motion is required. Joe noted no input yet from membership on events they have interest in the chapter attending other than zone and 50th Memorial Picnic.

Karon has been working with member Don Gibson to put together a 50th Logo for merchandise and it was displayed and met with approval of the board. Butch (Harold) Williams raised the question that if shirt cost can be lowered, we could sell more at our 50th. He then presented a T-shirt that Grant looked at which he got a Hobby Lobby for \$3.27. Butch noted they have multiple colors available and gave Grant his receipt. Grant noted that he used the same manufacturer and would also investigate cost option. Added discussion on shirts hinged around not knowing set up cost breakdown on numbers to print and cost of initial silk screening. Follow up on this pending next meeting. Karon proposed that we set a budget for food up to one thousand dollars (1,000.00) to get a vendor and not cook for ourselves as in past shows. A motion was made by Karon to spend the money and seconded by Grant. After discussion on an approved vendor list previously supplied by Ellen D. Santucci our Treasurer and input as to cost of other vendors, the motion passed. The question remains on which park approved vendor to select at this time. I also noted a backup vendor may be required. Ellen spoke next that the show flyer should include last shows winner vehicle with the winner's name. The board also agreed not to raise the entry cost for the show and keep it at fifteen dollars (\$15.) with day of show twenty dollars (\$20.) and second car of same entrant at eight dollars (\$8). As with past shows this is a rain or shine show.

Ellen discussed that a flyer for the show is needed to get insurance from the Oldsmobile Club of America and to get publication in the national Journey with Oldsmobile Newsletter. Flyers will also allow us to get the word out to publications and as handouts at our membership drive booths.

The next board meeting will again follow the next 9:30 a.m. White Elephant Sale Membership Meeting on March 12, 2022. (FYI At the membership meeting no one spoke up to any parts needed or for sale.)

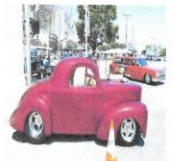

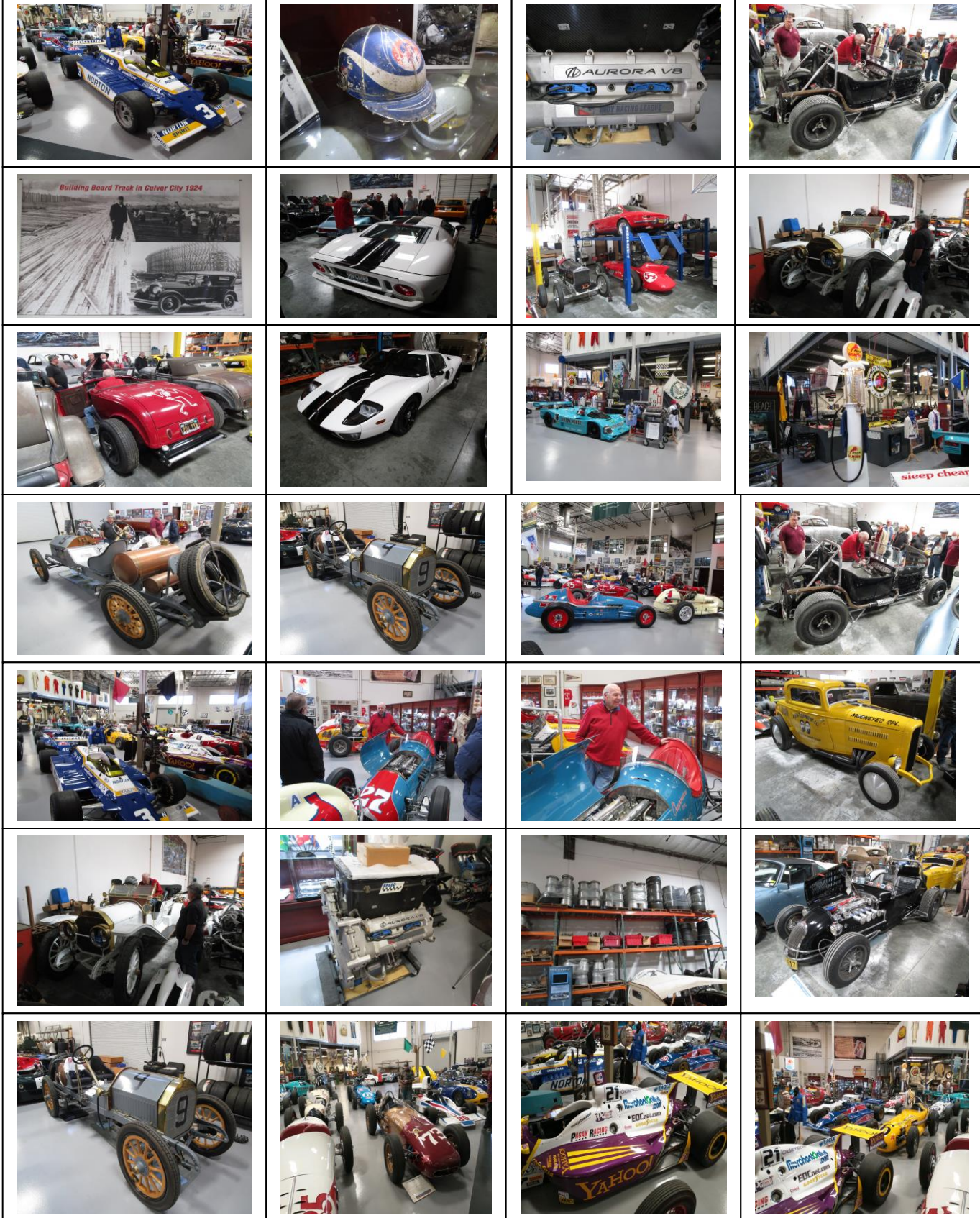
