Ask Your Zone Director

Here are the highlights of the May 11th OCA Board of Directors Zoom videoconference:

- Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Jeff Walsh reviewed the 2021 and 2020 year-to-date reports. We are off to a good start this year, with about a \$1,900 surplus so far. Outlook for the year remains guarded, given rising costs and unforeseen expenses such as the paper surcharge imposed by the JWO printer.
- President Sal noted the event liability insurance coverage issue affecting other clubs and thanked Past President Jerry Wilson for his work in making sure that our coverage is complete.
- 2022 National Meet: As of last Friday, 298 guests and 115 cars were registered. The number of registrations are picking up and expected to increase as we get closer to the May 25th deadline. Secretary Marcie noted that committee and other Board reports are due to her by May 22nd.
- 2023 and Later National Meets: OCA has issued Request for Proposal (RFP) to several cities in the central and northeastern U.S. The RFPs are the first step in finding appropriate venues for future National Meets. The RFPs are due before the July 6th Board meeting and an update will be presented to the Board.
- Membership Dues Increase: President Sal discussed his article about the dues increase, which will appear in the June JWO. He noted the alternatives to the increase, such as reducing the number of pages of each JWO issue, etc. Atlantic Northeast Zone Director Sal Cerrone mentioned that most everyone is aware of rising costs, he noted that a local car shows where the sponsors' award cost increased by \$50, thirty-five of the thirty-six sponsors accepted the increase.
- Promotional E-Memberships: Discussed and suggestion made to develop guidelines for this program.
- Zone Zoom Meetings: President Sal announced that these meetings will start after the National Meet.
- Advertising: Zone Director Sal Cerrone mentioned the bundling and pricing for National Meet Program Book advertising. President Sal agreed that crossover from Program Book ad sales to JWO is a good idea to close deals and bring in the ad revenue. Advertising Manager Jerry Wilson noted that invoices for current JWO advertisers have been issued. Treasurer Jeff noted that one or two invoices are still outstanding, payment has been received for all others.
- Miscellaneous: Volunteer photographers are still needed for the National Meet. Long-Term Membership Chair Cindy Klemm noted that thirty-seven members are eligible for their recognition gift this year. Interest in past OCA posters was noted on an online forum, Jerry Wilson researched the possibility of reprinting the posters, just need a volunteer to do the project, contact Jerry if interested. Pacific Northwest Zone Director Ed Konsmo bid the group goodbye, as he will not be attending the National Meet and did not run for another term. He has been on the Board since 1999. President Sal thanked Ed for his contributions to the OCA. Atlantic Northeast Zone Director Tom Aukzemas will oversee the National Meet Silent Auction and reminded everyone to send him their contributions to the auction.

The next Board meeting will be in-person at the National Meet, on July 6th.

First of all, thank you for re-electing me to another term as your OCA Pacific Southwest (PSW) Zone Director. I appreciate your support, and I will do my best to help provide value and benefit to your OCA membership.

We do have a second PSW Zone Director position that is vacant, meaning that our Zone does not have full representation on the OCA Board. Please consider volunteering for this vacancy to serve your fellow members and improve our club. There is a process to appoint a director to fill this vacancy between elections. Feel free to contact me if you are interested in volunteering.

Also, a reminder about the deadlines for the National Meet- your completed registration form must be postmarked no later than May 25th to be accepted. The same deadline applies for Member Car Photo submissions. Note that Chapter Display Ads for the National Meet Program Book must be <u>received</u> (not postmarked) by May 25th.

Here are the highlights of the March 9th OCA Board of Directors Zoom videoconference:

- Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Jeff Walsh reviewed the 2021 and 2020 year-to-date reports and will continue to do so at each of our bi-monthly Zoom meetings. Some of the revenue shortfall seen late last year has been partially recovered in the first two months of this year. Notable was an increase in dues revenue this year due to the individual member follow-ups by Office Manager Marsha Nicholas. We are off to a good start.
- New Member Promotion: President Sal suggested that OCA offer a small number of free one-year e-memberships to the chapters as a promotional/new member recruiting item. This would provide another benefit to the chapters from OCA. It was noted that for our last e-membership promotion (50% off e-membership to celebrate OCA's 50th anniversary), about one-third of the new members that signed up continued on as full-rate paid members. Details of this new promotion still need to be worked out, contact Sal with any comments and/or suggestions.
- Zone Zoom Meetings: President Sal will be sending out e-mails to Zone Directors and Chapter Presidents announcing open Zoom meetings for each Zone hosted by him to discuss any topics of interest or questions that members may have.
- 2022 National Meet: The New England Chapter is pooling resources for transportation and is arranging for a couple of commercial car carriers to transport some members' cars to the Meet. Eastern Great Lakes Zone Director Ken Nicholas challenged Board members to each donate an item to the Meet's silent auction; he will be donating an Oldsmobile-stained glass artwork. The Meet info and webpage links have been pinned to our Facebook page for easy reference. Jerry Wilson volunteered to lead the effort to have Oldsmobiles in the glass tower at the local GM dealership again.
- Commercial Advertising: Advertising Manager Jerry Wilson and President Sal have been looking at ways to increase ad revenue. Jerry has reviewed other clubs' publications for Oldsmobile-related companies. Webmaster Stefan noted that we should include electronic media (our webpage, social media pages, etc.) advertising in the discussions with potential sponsors. We receive analyticals (data) from Google regarding OCA website traffic; this can help advertisers track the effectiveness of their ads. One method of improving our website traffic may be to post our recommended repair shops list.
- Miscellaneous: Looking for volunteers interested in reviewing the current Zone boundaries and developing a proposal to readjust the boundaries to better reflect the current membership distribution- contact President Sal if interested. Secretary Marcie Ranick mentioned that committee reports for the July Board meeting will be due in early April- she will send out reminders.
