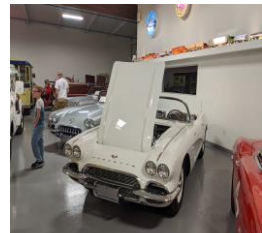

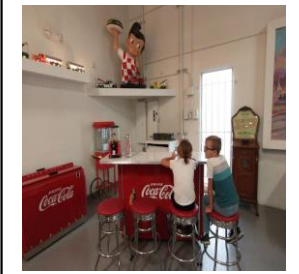

Board Meeting July 9, 2022, socialoldsmobile.com scribed by Domenic Santucci Secretary

Vice President, Grant Warner, led off the board meeting today after handing out an agenda. This meeting, following our membership meeting and kicked off late, as the membership meeting ran past our time slot. The restaurant had no other bookings and allowed us to remain in their banquet room. Ellen Santucci our Treasurer was next up to discuss our semi-annual report and she stated it would be ready before the next membership meeting. Also, Ellen noted she has had a volunteer list clip board returned to her from the membership meeting for the picnic and will continue to seek volunteer needs at meetings. Logistics on our picnic were next on topic. Scott Graham, our merchandise manager, had sold multiple 50th Anniversary T-shirts at the break and Ellen was passed the money to be returned to the club treasury. A need to know if our food Vendor was still on track with be for Ellen to inquire with Karon Pierce-Warner, our newsletter editor, if all needs that day were on track. Ellen stated we have the event signs and would post as we arrived at the event. Our next event was discussed on attending the Kent Browning Collection. An appropriate gift decided by an earlier board vote coming from the club merchandise inventory and it will be divulged at the next membership meeting. All attending the collection on July 23rd will be privy to it then. A surprise gift to be given to members was previewed to attendee's and one member "Race" Hare was reminded not to divulge the item. Discussion about how the item would be distributed and how the distribution, would be handled, will be discussed at future meetings. Our Editor, Karon, wanted to handle the item and Ellen our Treasurer spoke to her records with new members joining that she should handle the possession and distribution. A motion was made, after board discussion, by Area Representative, Joe Tannerbauer and seconded by multiples on the board, that the Treasurer should control and maintain the count till all get dispensed. The motion was approved that the treasurer not the newsletter editor will distribute the surprise item. The initial distribution was agreed on to be at the 50th Anniversary show to active members in attendance. All other distributions will be at membership events or by a form of mailing, if necessary, to be discussed in other meetings. As a club we still need to encourage flyer handouts at events that members can take the lead on to do their part in our 50th Anniversary Show success. Grant then passed out the actual picnic dash plaques that the Ellen will include in the picnic packets. After reviewed the plaques were collected and Ellen took control of the plaques to be inserted to the picnic packet. Grant recovered the awarded surprise gift item to his possession. Grant noted that the awards for the show are still on track to meet our event schedule. Grant noted he has reviewed the parking and will lay out for show needs. Grant noted that website updates for the show are available online. Randy Hare, Area Representative, spoke to allowing other automotive brands to enter the show to increase our volume. In discussion if someone wishes to park by the show with an off brand, that we plan on a location. Grant will select a location by the show field if some arrive. Conversation to do so was due to our flyer not saying Oldsmobile only and Grant noted that Oldsmobile is indicated by model in the judging class selections. Randy noted it is an opportunity to grow the show entries and revenues. Abeyance of this topic for future shows as seen with the zone show example is open to more discussion before our next show. On other events suggestions announced for later this year could be the Peterson or Movie Museum, the Day Collection, the Segerstrom Collection and in Oxnard the Peter Mullen Collection. The board will continue to look for member input on above mentioned locations or additional things members want to do. Grant next unveiled our new show banner that can be used also at our swap meet activity booth after our picnic. Grant asked members on the board yet to submit the written confirmation on club assets in their possession to do so. Grant closed the meeting after an open discussion on how the restaurant will do a planned remodel that could have a possible impact on a meeting. More to come as we get notifications from the new Streamliner Lounge owners.

Our meeting today was led by Vice President Grant Warner. Grant distributed the meeting agenda to all 21 in attendance. Grant called for our salute to the flag our pledge of allegiance. Grant called for first time attendees, and members in attendance, to announce themselves. After no response from attendee's Grant then introduced his grandson Wade Pierce. Wade will be taking a red 1994 Cutlass Supreme Convertible, from Grants collection to Oklahoma soon. Next on our agenda Grant called on our Treasurer to give her reports. Ellen D. Santucci passed around the room a get-well greeting to Steve Groves just recovering from recent surgery. Also passed around the room a get-well message card to Joel Carver in recovery from his past surgery. Ellen mentioned next that names she has furnished to Area Representative, Keith Berg, which need to be added to our chapters memorial display jacket. Ellen sent the list around the room for any attendee additions the board may have missed for Keith. Grant next recapped his Rocket Science Racing schedule and welcomed any that wanted to attend to watch are welcomed on 8/20-21. Grant also noted that Ryan Pierce fared better that day and the heat 103 degrees was a factor on why they did miss out on better results. He explained they lost their rigs AC and got knocked out in two rounds. Ryan cut a monumental 002 light and that was outstanding in racing. Next agenda item Grant mentioned Scott has chapter merchandise here with the new 50 Anniversary T-shirts at break time. A discussion on the new name Streamliner and menu came up with prices on menu appearing the same as with Arby's and that the 20% gratuity being needed for the use of the room. Ellen spoke up if someone fails to meet the 20% the difference will come out of the 50/50 revenue. **One** unknown failure referred to her by our server was covered by other adequate tips from other attendee's covering the difference this time. At break John Weaver with coaching from Scott, a prior winner, did today's ticket sales while Scott sold merchandise. Grant opened new business with news on drag cancellations from Joe Donley as at national meet it rained two days. The swap meet was impacted as rain led to lack of table displays. Our local events for May and June were discussed as open events members could attend as noted in prior newsletters. The July event is the Browning Collection and is on track for the 23rd of July with multiple Oldsmobile and Corvettes in his collection available for us to enjoy. Also included in this collection is a Series One Shelby designed Oldsmobile. Selection of an eatery for lunch were discussed such as Islands in Cerritos. Enjoy the last Wheels and Windmill Show and Mendenhall Museum BBQ this will be last on held in Solvang. The Mendenhall Collection also an oil can collection and examples of off-road racing with people notably Steve McQueen or James Gardner and Joe Mondello Oldsmobile engine upgrade impact on the sport.
