Board Meeting socaloldsmobile.com August 13, 2022, scribed by Domenic Santucci

Grant Warner opened the meeting reviewing the details or our 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary picnic and show celebration needs. First off, the food vendor, will deal with their setup for cooking and serving members with meal tickets. No late show registered entries, after September 14, get 2 free meals. If attend without a car, a meal purchase can be made by using the registration portion of the form additional lunch/s at \$15.00 each. You have the option as noted to purchase a lunch or bring your own including a non-alcoholic beverage. The chapter will place table covers on tables under the main reserved location shelter #1. In addition, at this site will be ticket sales for the raffle. Awards will be distributed at the end of the show. There will be a 50/50 raffle ticket for a cash sold during the show. Scott Graham will have a table under the shelter to sell club merchandise. Yes, our 50th Anniversary T-shirts will be available for you to purchase. The registration packet will be at the show registration table as you enter. Be sure to go through your packet for the show instructions, dash plaque, a decal and window class entry description window sheet. At last meeting it was suggested we allow non-Oldsmobile vehicles into the show. A 1st, 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup> award will be sponsored by the Hare Family. Possible discussion on next years show option or clarification of entry registration form is on abeyance. Voice your thoughts to the board members on the show and what you want to see as an option if any for next year with your feedback sheet. All the show permits have been obtained and our food vendor is insured and approved by the park. Our cost outlay at this point for the membership has been extensive this event is meant to give back and celebrate with our membership the club's golden anniversary. Our Treasurer as stated in our membership meeting, we have adequate funds to operate. As noted above we need more Raffle Prizes. As you canvas for raffle prizes take a show flyer with you to point out the legitimacy of our event. Randy Hare and Keith Berg noted next that updates on different web sites have been checked to get for accuracy the goal to get more entries to our show. We next review items we need to for the picnic. We need to purchase additional table plastic coverings, trash bags and to bring the 2 way radios, club canopy and back drop with weights, swap meet items, ice chests with ice for beverages, trophies, gift items from club, registrations supplies, OCA setup, signs and banners with club merchandise. Ellen reminded us that she will need a few things that need to be purchased for the show. On another event item, Randy is in discussion with the docents at the Castle Collection. He will provide feedback at the next meetings, membership and or board, or update our editor Karon Pierce-Warner with a flyer for the event if sooner. Look for flyers in your newsletter as Karon receives them also from other entities. Next month, September, is the month for two events to note. First off, we have at our meeting our semi-annual White Elephant Sale. We request if you have an item no longer need or bring it to the meeting to have members bid on. Please leave your Greasy at home. Grant and Butch will serve as our auctioneers. September Membership Meeting is the official opening of nomination for the 2023 board. Grant was asked to get our job profiles in this month's newsletter. All nominees must accept for the nomination to be official. You may nominate yourself. Write-in candidates are not accepted on chapter ballots, contact a board member, or attend a meeting, to get your name on the ballot. Multiple nominations can be made for any board office and the vote determines the winner. Ellen noted that the October Board Meeting is when the ballot is finalized. Our meeting site, although adequate for our needs at this point, may not be a long-term option and other venues need to continue to be investigated. Consider a centralized site, hours of operation, hours we can use the room, size of venue offered, adequate parking, day and time of week to accommodate our group and what cost are attributed if any to the location use. Presently we do not pay to use the room if members meet the 20% gratuity. Dave Walter an Area Representative noted he is in a different club that meets at the Sizzler by Harbor and Chapman that would meet our current needs. The board in the past has planned a visited to a site prior to making any move. Ellen noted she will check with our current location to verify we are not impacted by their 2023 remodel or changes in individual billing with an individual's 20% gratuity. On a final note, we always attempt to entertain our members with events and shows that we also would enjoy. The Lion's Museum tour has yet to develop. Feedback for our last zone show was discussed pertaining to a joint show within the zone if it would draw more cars from Ut, AZ, NV and CA stay tuned for options for the 2023 show. Grant is seeking feedback on the zone show from members attending this year before the board could entertain any further discussion.



#### Oldsmobile Club of Southern California Board of Directors Job Descriptions- Revised 8/10/2017

<u>President:</u> Presides over club general membership and board of directors' meetings including developing agendas and talking points for these meetings. Serves as the point person for club interaction with the public, other clubs, and entities wishing to solicit club participation in various events. Also has signature responsibilities for the club checking account and supervises any financial decisions the board may pursue or approve. The President also serves as the "tie breaker" vote on the board in the event it is needed to pass or defeat a motion before the board. Any disciplinary actions or policy changes are also the responsibility of the President to review and make recommendations to the board on direction to be taken whether it be a vote worthy issue or executive decision. This position is compensated with National dues being paid for by OCSC.

<u>Vice President</u>: Supports the President in all decisions and keeps current with all agendas and decisions in the event the President is unavailable to discharge the duties noted in the Presidents responsibilities. The Vice President also has signature rights on the club checking account and works closely with the club Treasurer to handle all financial matters as requested by the board. The Vice President must be available, sometimes at short notice to preside over meetings, club events, or financial matters in the absence of the President or as delegated by the President and / or general board. This position carries one regular vote on the board. This position is compensated with National dues being paid for by OCSC.

<u>Treasurer:</u> Supervises all club funds including the club checking account, club merchandise sales, membership renewals, donations, purchases, billings, and deposits / contracts as needed. The Treasurer is also responsible for generating a financial statement both for the board to review as well as to be published in the club newsletter. This position also requires close interaction with the Newsletter Editor and membership chairman / committee to insure all paid and current member information is passed along accordingly. This position also includes membership tracking for the purposes of securing timely renewals, maintaining current mailing / emailing lists for the newsletter, and developing accurate data for roster generation. This position carries one regular vote on the board. This position is compensated with National dues being paid by OCSC.

<u>Secretary:</u> Documents all discussions and proceedings at both the general membership as well as board meetings and forwards these notes to the newsletter editor for publishing in the newsletter each month. The Secretary will also, at the board's request, draft any written communication the board or club may deem necessary to any outside entities in response to information requests, public relations communication, follow up on contracts, etc.. This position carries one regular vote on the board. This position is compensated with National dues being paid by OCSC.

Newsletter Editor: Produces the monthly club newsletter (Rocket Circle) in both the mailed hardcopy form as well as email version. This includes compiling material and data as it becomes available, soliciting photos and articles from club members as well as outside entities, securing copies of the Secretaries notes for inclusion, and receiving / transpiring "wanted" and "for sale" ads from club meetings and swap meets for the newsletter. Also works closely with the Treasurer and membership chairman / committee to insure all current members are receiving their publication and expiring members are notified to renew. Includes securing postage as needed to mail the hard copies as well as working directly with the board approved printer to secure the printed versions of the newsletter. Also includes assembling, labeling, and affixing postage to the mailed copies before delivery to the post office.
