

### **MEMBER SPOTLIGHT SCOTT GRAHAM**

As a famous author once said (I forgot his name) I was born "....." in Los Angeles in 1939. My family has lived in the Los Angeles area since the mid- 1920's. My parents met on the Catalina "Great White Steam Ship" and were married in 1934. I grew up in West L.A . My father worked in the aircraft industry during WWII as a tool and die maker and eventually retired from the aerospace industry as a tool and die engineer and my mother was a stay-at-home housewife. We moved into our first home in 1948. I graduated from Hamilton High School in 1959.

I grew up during the Golden Age of hot rods, muscle cars, and car clubs. While in high school, I joined a car club called the Rim Runners with members in Los Angeles and the San Fernando Valley. We would "hang out" at Bob's Big Boy in Van Nuys on the weekends.

My first car was a 1948 Packard which my father passed down to me. My father was never one to be particularly devoted to one car manufacturer. We owned: Chryslers, Oldsmobiles, Fords, Chevrolets and a few imports that were all 3-5 years old. We never owned a new car, that was a luxury that our family could not afford. The first car I purchased with my own money was a 1950 gray 4-door Oldsmobile in 1958. When I graduated from High School, two of my friends and I took a trip (in the Oldsmobile) to Billings, Montana to visit my friend's girlfriends (who had moved there from Southern California). We spent time in the Grand Tetons and Lake Tahoe area before coming back to Southern California. After returning from Montana the Oldsmobile was damaged in an accident and I removed the engine and put it in a 1940 Ford that I turned into a "hot rod" and drove for 6 months. In 1960 I joined the Naval Air Reserve at Los Alamitos. I served in the Navy from 1960-1968 as a radar operator and as an air crew member on an anti-submarine warfare aircraft.


I married my first wife in 1961 and had 3 children, Christopher, Kimberly and Dina. We purchased our first home in Saugus in 1963 and lived there until 1966 when we moved to Pomona due to my work. We divorced in 1969 and I moved back to the Los Angeles area.

I moved to West Los Angeles and as luck would have it, fell in love with my next-door neighbor, Linda, who is currently my wife of 47 years. We now live in the "remodeled version" of the house that I grew up in. Linda loved my parents and the neighborhood, so it was a "no brainer". I purchased my first Oldsmobile (since the 1950 Olds) in 1986 and sold it 2 years later. It was a 1969 Aztec gold 442.

My next Oldsmobile was a 1968 Hurst Olds purchased from a collector in the San Fernando Valley, which I still have today.

After the 1968 Hurst I bought a 1983 Hurst Olds, then a 1975 Hurst Olds. The 1983 Hurst was stolen out of our driveway on a Saturday night, and eventually wound up "chopped shopped" in East L.A. My friend, Grant, and I picked the car up and brought it back to my house where I "parted" it out.

I joined the Oldsmobile Club in 1988 and have served as president, treasurer, and area representative. I am also a member of the Oldsmobile Club of America, and the Hurst Olds Club of America.

## Ask Your Zone Director

Here are the highlights of the July 12<sup>th</sup> OCA Board of Directors Zoom videoconference:

Treasurer Jeff Walsh started the meeting with the financial report. For the first six months of the year, income was down about three percent and expenses were up about three percent. Journey With Olds (JWO) printing and distribution costs continue to rise significantly (about ten percent). We have a net loss of about \$9k for the period (1<sup>st</sup> six months). Jeff recommended continuing to pursue additional advertisers to increase our income. He also noted that upon membership renewal, there is now an option to donate to the OCA as well as the R.E. Olds Museum.

Vice President Bob reported that there are now about twenty-seven racers signed up for the Thursday afternoon races at the National Meet. Some are traveling long distances, we should have cars from Arizona, Florida, Canada, Wyoming, among the crowd. One race has been changed to 1/8 mile from ¼ mile for safety reasons. All racers in that class were contacted and agreed to the change. Fun racing is still an option for Meet attendees, \$25 charge, but no payout as with the other racing classes. Credit card payments will be accepted at the gate.

2023 National Meet: President Sal and National Meet Committee member Pat are working with the Marriott (host hotel) on final event room assignments. Registration is now closed, 856 people (414 members) are signed up for the Meet. There are about thirty people still on the waiting list for the host hotel, cancellations are occurring, but fewer than in the past few years. As the cancellations occur, those spots are filled with people from the waiting list. 326 cars are registered for the show field and 156 swap spaces have been sold. Still need volunteers, Alan Wilcox is the volunteer coordinator. Bring items for donation to the Silent Auction! President Sal invited Board members and spouses to dinner after the Board meeting, please RSVP to him so he can make a reservation.

Miscellaneous Items: Dave Leash (GM Club Apparel) is offering a \$10 merchandise discount to new OCA members. Secretary Marcie asked everyone to read the Board item package before the Board meeting. Looking for a new Webmaster as recent volunteer Mark had to step back for personal reasons. (Since this meeting, PNW Zone Director Cole has volunteered for the position.) President Sal asked for location suggestions for the 2025 National Meet. South Central Zone Director Bryan suggested Reno, NV. (Yes, we will contact Reno for 2025.)

The next Board meeting is scheduled for August 8<sup>th</sup> during the National Meet.

Socialoldsmobile.com Membership Meeting July 8, 2023, scribed by club Secretary Domenic Santucci President Randy Hare opened today's meeting with a pledge of allegiance to our national flag. Randy asked for any new members or guest to announced themselves. No new attendees were recognized, and Randy noted a welcome back, attending today, Russ Golesh. Randy also noted an ongoing support for a member Greg Drusch. Greg lives in Corona, CA. Currently members of the board himself, Grant Warner, Karon Pierce-Warner and Dave Walters also want club member support. Call or email them for updated wants and needs. Next Treasurer Ellen D. Santucci was called on for her report. First off Ellen spoke to adequate reserves to carry on club business. Ellen noted that the June and semi- annual reports are pending as more final status on the zone show are not in. A card for Linda Williams due to recover from eye surgery and the want/sale ad sheet for Karon the newsletter editor. Karon on vacation was not present to discuss any newsletter update information. I was called on for approval of last month's newsletter minutes. Noted by member Milton Yee his name was miss spelled as a zone show winner and the update was noted. A call for approval of the minutes motion from Russolesh and seconded by Area Representative Butch Williams. The motion voted on by attendees passed. A recap on our last event to the home of Kim Tucker and his shuttle arrangement for a round trip up to the Griffith Observatory was noted and a presentation of a club logo sign followed at the meeting conclusion. Randy then called on an attendee to volunteer to do a club spotlight article for the newsletter. Scott Graham our Merchandise Manager will submit an article to the newsletter editor. Randy next promoted an event at the "So. Cal. Variety Cars and Coffee show noting last event had seventy (70) vehicles. His contact information on event is on page two of our club newsletter. Jim Charlesworth and Milton Yee are noted membership drive host for space J2 ant the LB Swap Meet tomorrow and the August Event. Keith Berg and grandson member Harley Berg will be manning their own booth in row J with 50's items they promote. 50/50 tickets were sold by Race Hare and Randy at the break and next month as todays winner I will sell tickets. Following the break, the next event spoken to was on the July 29<sup>th</sup> Lion's Automobilia event with around a ten-dollar (\$10.00) entry. A reserve parking area cost of \$275.00 was prohibitive and 10:00am arrival suggested we park close together and noting a close lunch site following the event. An August event at the Peterson Museum was discussed and that included trying to get into the lower vault as car themes on the show floors change from time to time. I noted that bringing show cars at times get to park in lower parking structure levels and not on the parking structure roof. Check the museum for current activity parking and cost. In September the Segerstrom Shelby Event Center at the Santa Ana site was discussed. I next raised the topic that September opens nominations for the club board. In your area for the show request items or service or service discounts for our memorial show raffle. Bring them to a meeting or on show date. Tell the donator that a three (3) month free ad will appear in newsletter monthly. The next club chapter meeting in the City of Orange on Aug 12, Sept 12<sup>th</sup>, and October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023, starting at 9:30am in the Streamliner Lounge. Nominations close at the October Board Meeting for board officers. We are currently looking for suggestions to hold our Holiday Banquet let us know of a location you want considered. Ellen wants you to get in your registration forms **now** for the Memorial Club Picnic. Ellen spoke to the meal at the event as a plate with a four-inch (4) BBQ pulled Pork or smoked chicken topped with/without:-peanut , cranberry coleslaw choice of 2 sides: mac and cheese-baked beans-potato salad-and a bag of chips. An extra meal not included with registration guidelines can be purchased for fifteen dollars (\$15.00) after the ticket meal holders pass through the line from the vendor at the same cost. Randy next closed the meeting with a final parts call and invited non board members to the following board meeting.

Socialoldsmobileclub.com Board Meeting July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023, Scribed by Secretary Domenic Santucci  
Randy Hare President opened our meeting with discussions on merchandise. Randy asked if the last hat order was available for the zone show. Ellen D. Santucci noted that she assisted with merchandise sales at the zone show and hats from the last order were available at \$30.00 each in burgundy and beige. Merchandise was given to Vice President Grant Warner and bring to the event. Next a note on club assets raised about reducing the old merchandise available to members first to the original sale price. Reduction in older and outdated inventory could lead revenue to offset the new products we offer and produce offset cost. A current available product list is out of date and items no longer available should be removed and updates posted at the reduced sale price. It was noted by Ellen, that Scott Graham our Merchandise Manager, brought merchandise to the membership meeting today and made some sales. The next item on Randy's agenda which he distributed at all meetings was to reach out for guest speakers to give a short talk on car or other support services they offer. Meeting times are governed by the Streamliner Lounge and that needs to be conveyed to any speakers for a short presentation and answer session up to thirty (30) minutes. Randy must first approve the speaker topic and provide the time and date for the presentation. Our next topic agenda was on the September White Elephant sale and open nominations for the 2024 Board Member nominations. All attending this meeting were reminded that self-nomination and active member (paid up) can nominate a candidate. Nominated candidates must accept their nomination to be considered for a ballot on appointment. Treasurer Ellen D. Santucci noted that she mails out for membership renewals after the October Board Meeting closes. If required a ballot request will be included which will include a self-addressed stamped return envelope. If a Board Bylaw Office has not more than the candidates required to hold an office nomination no ballot will be mailed. Next Randy addressed the web page and a need for attention to assure updated information. Race Hare as an appointed liaison to assist with web postings. He will be looking at how the chapter can address a site to keep the club and public updated. Race noted a Domain name would amount to possibly \$16.00 monthly for \$192.00 yearly. Race would then control media for sites like Facebook and Instagram after board approval. An adequate number of the board must approve this motion number of this motion by Ellen and second from Butch (Harold) Williams. On an added note, Race and Randy will get 50 Oldsmobile sites posted for the annual picnic for the next three months. Ellen asked for a motion to renew the membership drive space J2. Area Representative Dave Walter made the motion, and another board member Butch (Harold) Williams seconded the motion. The motion was passed by board attendees and Randy will check with non-attendees. **Randy** will check with **other** board members not in attendance for their approval. The motion made is for the next six (6) events space J2 at the Long Beach Swap Meet. The next topic raised by Randy, was related to ballot counting and that last picnic. One point raised was of the high volume of registration may have led to time constraint requirements to count the ballots. Randy noted he would prefer a counting of ballots as received by volunteers appointed/volunteered for the task. One other item raised was the fact of time to start the meals and volunteers at the show to eat first so they may can cover another needed task. A set up line should be designated for the event meals. Show registration was noted as the prime mover for the ballot counting methods. A topic raised by Ellen under newer business was our outdated quantity of business cards. New card orders and discuss will be in obedience until future meetings. I noted that anyone working the swap space J2 must ensure that the club tote with required show, or registration, or applications are in the bag with the entry pass. The club will reimburse copy cost on twenty-five (25) individual subject items required for display with a receipt. Ellen has the new pass for the swap meet J2 space ahead now and will bring it to the next membership meeting. On a final discussion a location for our holiday banquet has yet to be determined. The last event here held years past could only accommodate tight spaced forth five (45) attendees. Let Randy know of a location that could support a banquet. The manager here was not available today for an inquiry.




