


August 12, 2023, Board Meeting socaloldsmobile.com scribed by Secretary Domenic Santucci

President Randy Hare distributed agenda minutes and then opened our meeting. First getting guest speaker and that was left to individuals on the board and members of the club to help with suggestions. We need a short fifteen-minute presentation as our room time is limited. Next 2024 Board nomination will open at the September Membership Meeting. You may nominate yourself if you wish to serve. All board positions are available to candidates' seeking re-election and active members of the club wanting to run. Our member Patrick Chevalier said he could help with the development of our updated club website. It was suggested we keep our current domain name and arrange for the administrators to be changed. It was motioned and approved to Send Don Gibson \$44.00. To Cover 2023/2024 the cost for our dominant name. Vice President Grant Warner made a motion that we keep our current domain name, and our newsletter editor Karon Pierce-Warner seconded the motion. A vote to accept the motion was put to the board for a vote and it passed. On the next agenda was our annual memorial Picnic, Randy noted that 50 websites now have information on our show. A repost will occur in the first weeks of September and October. A motion by Karon, seconded by Grant was made to raise the club dues to yearly renewal of \$25.00. The motion came after discussion of the cost for printing and distribution of the 15 mailed newsletters this year. Which is \$633.00. Which means it requires 42 members' dues at 15.00 each to cover the newsletter expenses for 15 members. Treasurer Ellen D. Santucci spoke about the cost of the 50th anniversary event. It was noted that a large show turnout helped with expenses. It was noted by Randy that a donation made by a member that day helped to cover the cost of the show. Randy reminded everyone that in the last few years the trophies for that event have been donated by a member, so we did not incur that cost. It was also noted that the membership dues must offset the cost of operation and rising costs in the public sector. I asked if the motion would leave the associate dues at \$3.00 and that cost will remain the same. I also asked if joining in the current year from September on will still afford new members an extension to December first of the following year. A yes agreement was reached on both questions. We must be good stewards of our clubs' finances. Randy called for a vote on the motion to raise the dues after a lengthy lively discussion on the pros and cons of raising dues followed. Treasurer Ellen D. Santucci pointed to her book of records and that spending to dues increases must be in line. It was also noted that the 50th Anniversary Show Items cost were factored in and a gift to commemorate or 50th year together and highlight the event, example: a banner, tokens, and merchandise. A close vote was taken by the board members in attendance. The motion to increase the dues to \$25.00 passed. Randy next noted that the Holiday Banquet menu at this point is not known and will be based on a \$30.00 or \$35.00 cost. The discussion was tabled until next month on cost. Banquet fees will include museum access and dinner. Time allotted will be from 2-6 p.m. for the meal, meeting and touring within the museum.

Oldsmobile Club of Southern California Board of Directors Job Descriptions

President; Presides over club general membership and board of directors' meetings including developing agendas and talking points for these meetings. He/She serves as the point person for club interaction with the public, other clubs, and entities wishing to solicit club participation in various events. Also has signature responsibilities for the club checking account and supervises any financial decisions the board may pursue or approve. The President also serves as the "tie breaker" vote on the board in the event it is needed to pass or defeat a motion before the board. Any disciplinary actions or policy changes are also the responsibility of the President to review and make recommendations to the board on direction to be taken whether it is a vote worthy issue or executive decision. This position is compensated with National dues being paid for by OCSC.

Vice President: Supports the President in all decisions and keeps current with all agendas and decisions in the event the President is unavailable to discharge the duties noted in the Presidents responsibilities. He/she assumes the responsibilities of the President. The Vice President also has signature rights on the club checking account and works closely with the club Treasurer to handle all financial matters as requested by the board. The Vice President must be available, sometimes at short notice to preside over meetings, club events, or financial matters in the absence of the President or as delegated by the President and / or general board. This position carries one regular vote on the board. This position is compensated with National dues being paid for by OCSC.

Treasurer: Supervises all club funds including the club checking account, club merchandise sales, membership renewals, donations, purchases, billings, and deposits/contracts as needed. The Treasurer is also responsible for generating a financial statement both for the board to review as well as to be published in the club newsletter. This position also requires close interaction with the Newsletter Editor and Membership Chairman/Committee to insure all paid and current member information is passed along accordingly. This position carries one regular vote on the board. This position is compensated with National dues being paid by OCSC.

Secretary: Documents all discussions and proceedings at both the general membership as well as board meetings and forwards these notes to the Newsletter Editor for publishing in the newsletter each month. The Secretary will also, at the board's request, draft any written communication the board or club may deem necessary to any outside entities in response to information requests, public relations communication, follow-up on contracts, etc.. This position carries one regular vote on the board. This position is compensated with National dues being paid by OCSC.

Newsletter Editor; Produces the monthly club newsletter (Rocket Circle) in both the mailed hardcopy form as well as email version. This includes compiling material and data as it becomes available, soliciting photos and articles from club members as well as outside entities, securing copies of the Secretaries notes for inclusion, and receiving/transpiring "wanted" and "for sale" ads from club meetings and swap meets for the newsletter. Works closely with the Treasurer and Membership Chairman/Committee to insure all current members are receiving their publication and expiring members are notified to renew. He/she also secures postage as needed to mail the hard copies as well as works directly with the board approved printer to secure the printed versions of the newsletter. He/she also assembles labels, and affixes postage to the mailed copies before delivering them to the post office. This position carries one regular vote on the board and is compensated with National dues being paid by OCSC.

Area Representative: (6 positions) Reaches out to current and perspective club members in their area and helps membership stay in contact with the club. This includes following up with expired members for potential renewal, soliciting new members at other car events and at the local swap meets, assisting current members in their area with club matters, volunteering to man club membership booths, and any other related duties. Also is expected to participate in club events as volunteers to help set up shows, secure club supplies as directed by the board, seek out or solicit new event locations and ideas, and secure information on member suggestions for events. This position carries one regular vote on the board and is compensated with local chapter dues being paid by OCSC.


