I just discovered that my "battery problem" on my '40 Olds (after buying a new one...), was in fact the positive battery CABLE (about 4 years old) having a slight bit of corrosion under the crimp connector at the starter end!! <u>Overview: Legislation (SB 1239)</u> has been reintroduced in the California Senate by Sen. Ted Gaines to exempt all motor vehicles prior to the 1981 model year from the emissions inspection requirement. Current law requires the lifetime testing of all 1976 and newer model-year vehicles. The bill will be considered in the Senate Transportation and Housing Committee.
