31st Annual Pacific Southwest Zone Show By Jon Manji

It seems we've settled into our new location, the SeaCrest Oceanfront Hotel in Pismo Beach. New to us last year, the SeaCrest has proven to be popular with our show attendees as our attendance increased this year. And we'll stay at the SeaCrest next year. Now, back to this year. With little fog and daytime temperatures in the 70s, the great weather contributed to everyone's enjoyment of the show and other activities. Showgoers were treated to an Oldsmobile assortment from the 1940s to the 1990s, from showroom stock to active race cars. One of the good qualities of a smaller show like ours is the ability to see many cars and talk with the owners, something that's often difficult to do at larger, busier shows. I think most of us have attended large shows where parking can be challenging, as well as just getting around to see all of the cars on display. One can feel overwhelmed at a large show. Not so at our Zone Show. The Friday Night Mixer again proved popular, with increased attendance over last year. We are very fortunate to have Karon Pierce-Warner of So-Cal Chapter in charge of all of the food and beverage arrangements for Friday and Saturday, as everyone went away well-fed and with food for later, if they wished. Saturday's Dessert Bar also went well, with about 55 people attending and enjoying the wide assortment of desserts and beverages. The Show is the focal point of the weekend, and provided a great opportunity to swap stories about our Oldsmobiles, learn more about the brand, and have a great time. New this year was something we called "Photo Hour," an hour in the afternoon after judging was concluded where we asked all participants to close up their Oldsmobiles for the benefit of the photographers present. Many automotive editors tell photographers, "No pictures of alligators," a reference to a car with its hood up, looking like an alligator in profile. At many shows, it's difficult to get photos of cars with the hoods and doors closed, so we thought we'd try the Photo Hour this year. It seems to have worked well and we'll do it again next year. I was unable to be at the Hotel on Friday to setup the show field and help people get their cars parked. Grant Warner, Joe Tannerbauer, Larry Ewing, & Dan Haggerty took care of these very important tasks for me and I want to thank them for doing so. Also of special note is Bob Griffith's volunteer work as a Judge this year. Bob responded to my request for more Judges in the last Oldsletter and came to the Show just to judge. These are just a few of the people that make participating in our events such a pleasure, thanks guys! Board Meeting Minutes, June 10th, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:35pm immediately followed by the pledge of allegiance and call for guest introductions of which one, Dominic Santucci, was in attendance.

Scott Graham: Treasurers report we are solvent. He reported that the Zone Show event reconciliation documented a net loss of \$199.30 for the entire event which was split between the Nor Cal and So Cal clubs for a -\$99.65 result to our treasury.

There was also a motion made and passed by unanimous vote to increase the treasury allotment originally for \$350.00 by another \$137.00 for purchasing new club merchandise stock to offset what was sold at the Zone Show.

Scott reported that the club had received a "thank you" letter from the R.E.Olds Museum for the donations made to them by club members who selected this option in lieu of receiving a trophy at the Zone Show.

Old Business:

Upcoming events were reviewed including the Orange Empire Railway museum tour on June 13th, Ruble Castle tour on July 11th which is still short 4 sign ups to get the official tour, Wheels & Windmills car show on August 29th (sold out but there is a waiting list), possible alternate August event at the Western Museum of Flight, and the Memorial Picnic / Car Show on September 20th.

In light of the recent passing of dear friend and long term club member Al Wilson, the board discussed the current bereavement policy and a motion was made and seconded with unanimous vote to modify the current policy to offering a financial gift of \$100.00 either directly to the surviving family members or donate that amount to a charity of their choice and eliminating the offering of flowers at a service.

The new membership renewal process was again discussed as the board continues to fine tune the roll out of the new synchronized renewal date of December 1st for all members. The motion was made, seconded, and passed that any member who had already renewed in the first quarter of 2015 and that renewal carried them into the 2016 calendar year, that they would receive an extended membership at no additional cost until December 1st of 2016 at which point all members would be due at the \$15.00 cost for 2017 membership. A special notice for those members affected by this change will be included in their voting ballot / renewal mailing sent out in October. All other modifications to the new renewal process previously voted on will still be in effect.

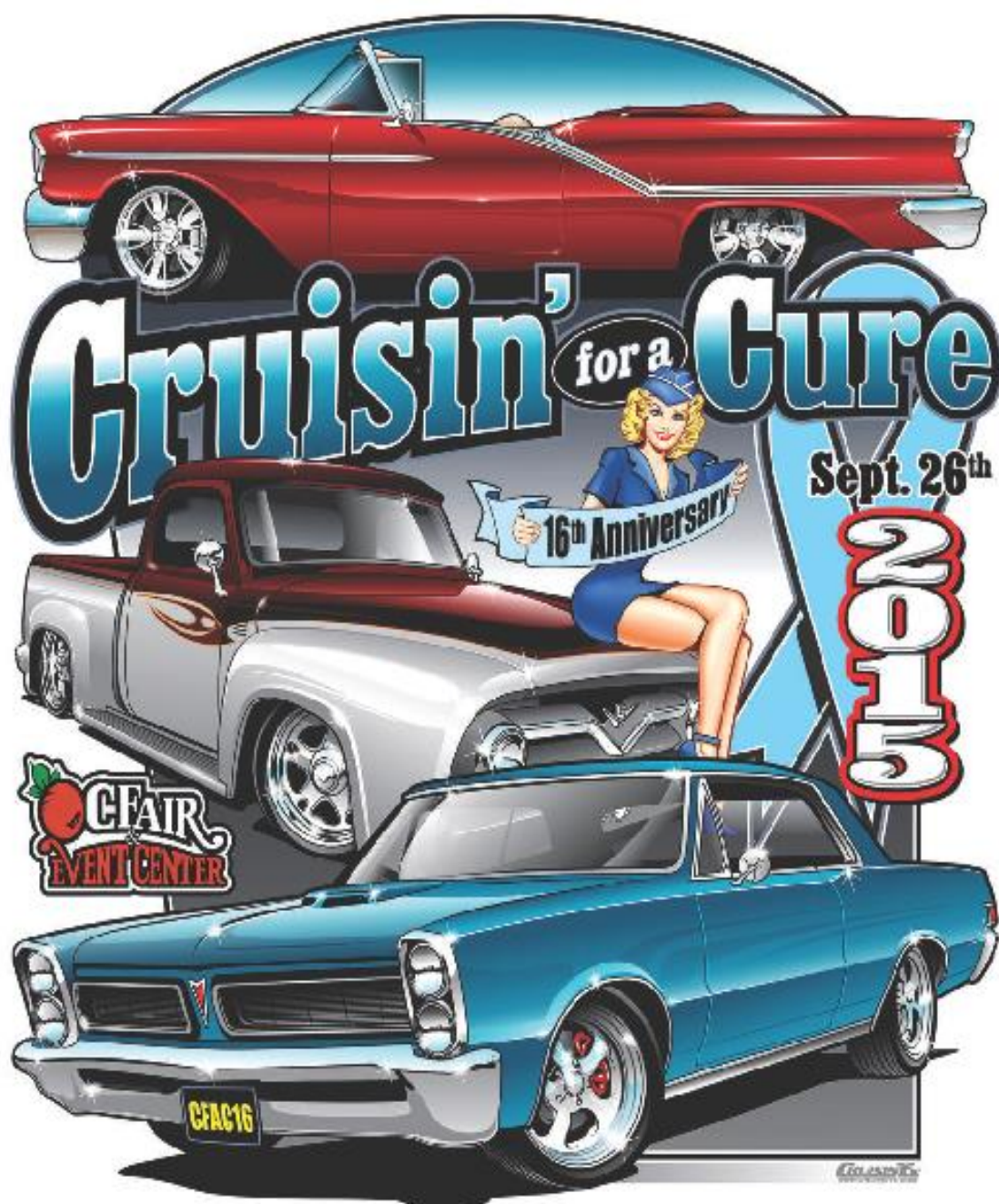

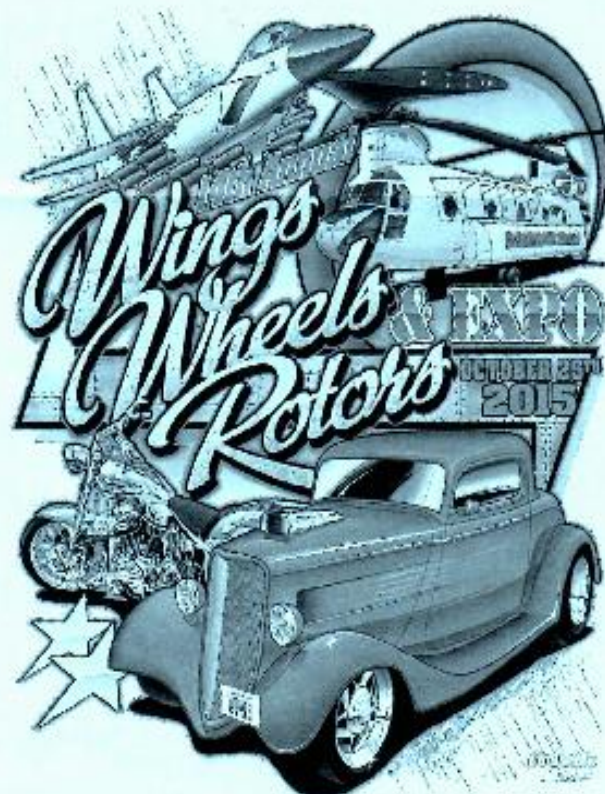
