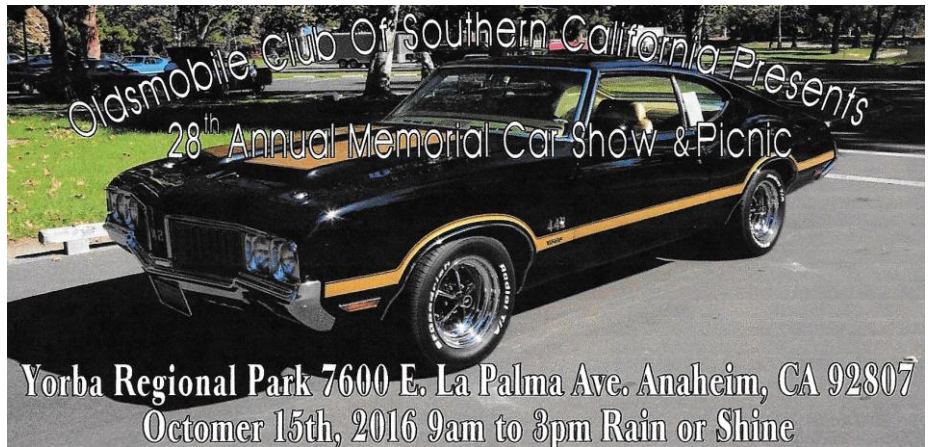

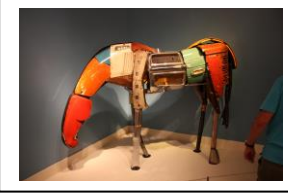
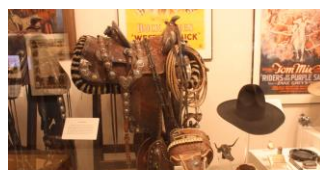

2016 "WHEELS 'N' WINDMILLS" CAR SHOW

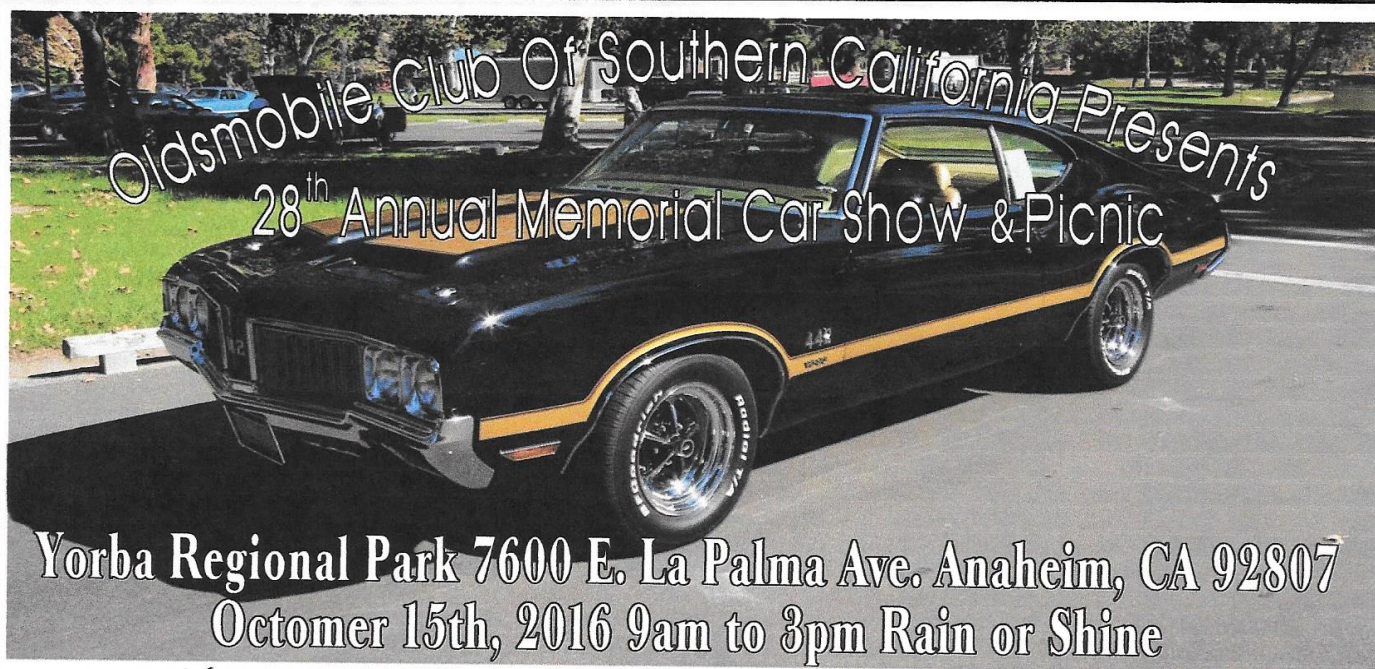

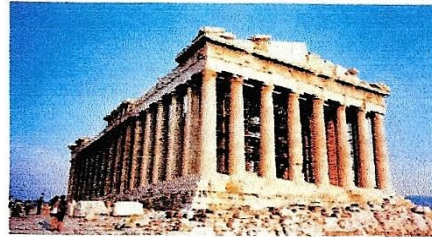

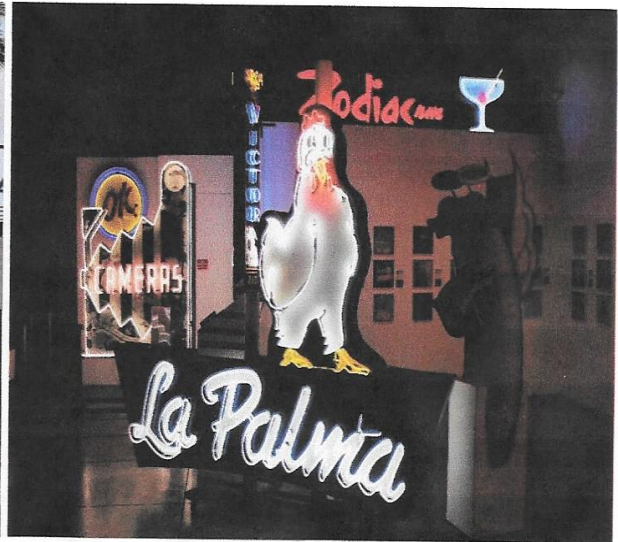
This issue will feature member articles from those who are current/retired, police officers, fire fighters and EMTs.

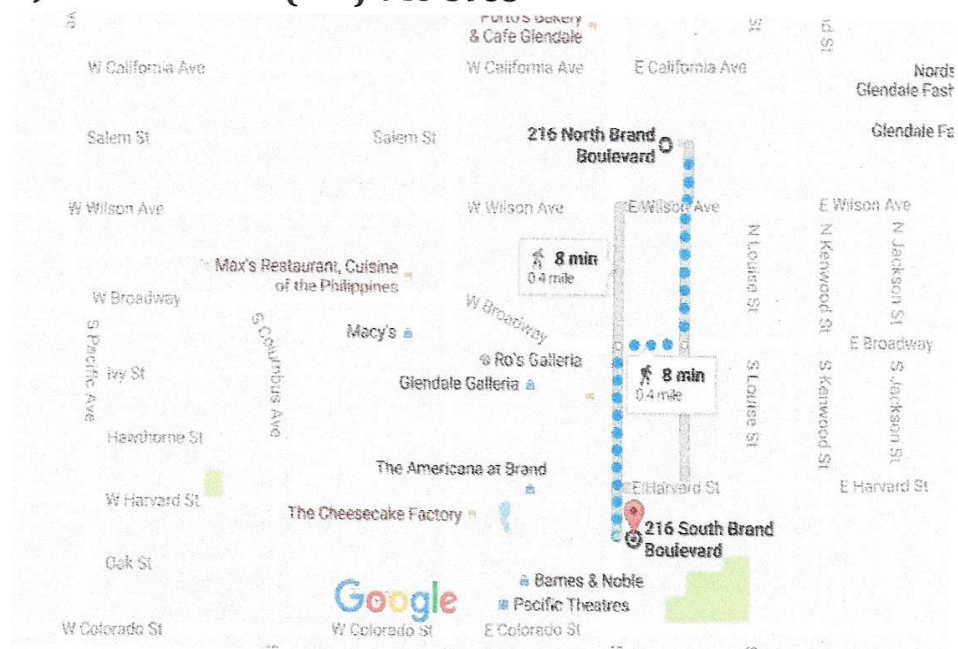

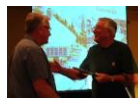
