January 8, 2020 Monthly Membership Meeting scribed by Domenic D. Santucci Chapter Secretary.

Kicking off the new year Joe Tannerbauer Area Representative opened tonight's meeting with our traditional flag salute. Joe called on Treasurer Ellen D. Santucci to give her monthly report. Ellen noted that ample funds are available to conduct chapter business. Ellen also passed a card around the room for signatures to mail to the family of Gary Wiemann, an Oldsmobile enthusiast that recently passed away. Ellen noted she sent an updated list of Active Members to Newsletter Editor Karon Pierce-Warner. To date Ellen noted that the year 2019 ended with 167 Members and 32 Associate Members. Ellen also noted our current renewals as of today stand at 116 with 32 associates. A clip board was passed around the room for any sale or want ads on Oldsmobile related items for Karon. Joe next asked for approval of last month's newsletter minutes. Scott Graham made a motion to accept the minutes with a second coming from Al Slater. A call for question on the motion discussion led to a vote that passed the motion. Joe noted that on the board, President and one Area Representative Office remain open. A board vote on appointments to an office may take place at a later date. A request for an active member to volunteer to fill the positions and duties of the available offices is ongoing. Joe asked anyone considering a position to attend our next or any board meeting to gain knowledge of what the board does. Joe noted that when he worked the December Swap Meet at Long Beach attendance from the attendee's was slow. Joe is also the volunteer for January and February. If you wish to work the swap meet even take the lead in February let him know. Currently the chapter has paid up swap space J2 until the April date. Joe asked for and received positive feedback on the recent Holiday Brunch at the Warner's in Perris, C.A. Also noted was that donations for the Orangewood Foundation transitioning out youth at age eighteen was high. Karon asked that those that have pictures from events to post them to our Facebook she can pull them from FB for the Newsletter and Website. Ellen again called for a volunteer to assist the chapter in review of media sites to assist the board in posting chapter events. Our request to attend the Day Car Collection in Corona has yet to gain an invitation and cancelled that event this month. February 1 is the San Juan Car Show and will be our event for the month. Karon was to email a flyer out to members after the meeting. March 27th is the Arizona event for the club and May 2th kicks off our Clovis Zone Show with the BOPC charity event. Volunteers are needed and the more that sign up the less work it will be for all reducing cars to judge to a 4-5 car field. On new business Scott reminded he had club merchandise here tonight and two old rosters to purchase at \$2.00 each. I noted that rosters are proprietary and only members are entitled to purchase them. Joe asked for any parts of sale item needs and with none offered called for the raffle ticket pull that included two 2020 calendars. Art Whitney won the money raffle and will sell tickets at our next membership meeting on February fifth.

Joe Tannerbauer, Area Representative, opened tonight's meeting noting that no guest is present and then moved on to or traditional Pledge of Allegiance. Joe called on Ellen D. Santucci for her financial report. Ellen distributed to the board her yearly financial report to board members in attendance. Ellen will forward to any of the board not in attendance tonight a copy of this report. Ellen then noted that the chapter has adequate funds to operate. Joe next spoke to low turnout at the January Long Beach Swap Meet. He noted that if he is not contacted by a member to cover February 9th, he would also work that membership drive. Joe is looking for anyone with an interest in attending the Arizona All Oldsmobile Show on March 27th to contact him on possibly forming a caravan. Joe also noted that there will be no major league baseball activity in Scottsdale that weekend and hotel rates should be cheaper and easier to book. Joe next spoke to the San Juan car show on February first (1) as our overlap January event. We are still looking for an event to promote in April and if any member has a location, they want to promote for the club they should let the board know. The **month** of **May** kicks off the combined Zone show with the Pontiac Club in Clovis, C.A. Registration includes separate registration forms to enter a car you must supply **both** entrance forms and fees for the zone show and to the Pontiac GM show. If you have **two** cars to enter, **each** car must have its **own entry** form filled out and fees submitted to get judged properly. The Clovis show is always in need of more volunteers to cover judging, please step up and help the clubs. On August 8th the Chapter calendar event will be an annual car show held at The Enderle Center in Tustin just off the 55 Freeway at 17th Street. Ellen next made a motion to pay (\$200) two hundred dollars for a parks fee to register our Annual Memorial Picnic site and date. Butch Williams seconded the motion and it was passed. Discussion notes were that **no** Saturday dates are available as they are pre-booked at the end of September through October. At this point I reminded attendees that the March and September membership meeting will be our event fundraiser for the zone and picnic shows. It was decided that there will be no December Board Meeting. Ellen next made a motion that February should be a cutoff on mailed/email newsletter copies to those that have not renewed their memberships. I seconded the motion. It was noted in discussion that the mailing list Ellen would send Karon on the current 119 membership with 22 associates to assist to prepare a future roster. If anyone failed to renew their membership by the February Newsletter they will not be in the new roster under development. It was also a method to alert those late on their renewal applications which all were mailed to them back in September of 2019. The motion Ellen made passed and Karon will get the motion update. Ellen prior to adjournment of our meeting made a motion to donate \$150.00 to The PADRE Diabetes Organization in Orange, C.A. as a first quarter donation. Butch seconded the motion and the attending board past the motion. Joe adjourned the meeting and noted that the next Membership Meeting will be on February fifth (5) 2020.
