Membership Meeting 1-9-2019 socialoldsmobile.com scribed by Secretary Domenic D. Santucci

Our 2019 President, Joe Tannerbauer, open the meeting with a traditional flag salute. He also noted no guest were at the meeting. Joe next called on our Treasurer to give her report on the chapter finance status. Ellen D. Santucci made an announcement of Sandy Roe's passing. She then distributed a clip board around the meeting for signatures. The clip board had an ad page, a get well card, a bereavement card and a letter from the Orangewood Children's and Family Center acknowledging 40 chapter holiday donations. 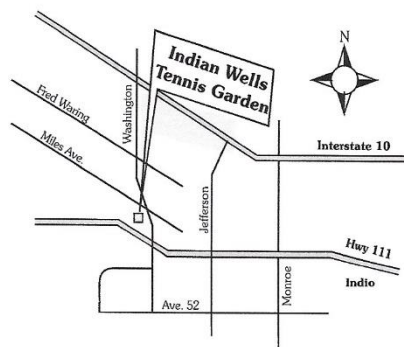

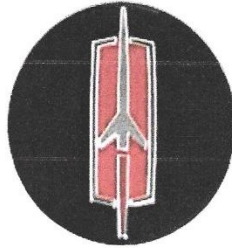

Holiday Greetings to all Northern and Southern California Oldsmobile Chapter Members!

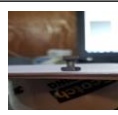
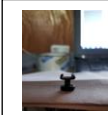
