#### Stock Classes

Vehicle may not have any modifications listed under the definition of the Modified classes. Vehicle should have a stock appearance. No more than 3 of the following changes will be allowed in the stock class: Non-stock appearing intake/carburetor, exhaust manifolds, headers, wheels/tires (within appropriate size range and style to be age appropriate and to be consistent with a stock appearance), ignition, radiator, AC compressor, auxiliary gauges, battery cables and other items considered as minor. If more than three changes are detected during judging, the score for the vehicle may be adjusted. In addition to these items, paint will not have to necessarily match an OEM color but should be done in a manner that does not distract from the stock appearance. If two or more vehicles are considered tied during judging, the most stock appearing vehicle will prevail. 


